## RECOMMENDATIONS

Provide feedback and direction on the City's membership in the Monterey Peninsula Regional Water Authority.

### **BACKGROUND**

On January 12, 2012, Council authorized the Mayor to sign a joint exercise of powers agreement to form the Monterey Peninsula Regional Water Authority (MPRWA) joining Pacific Grove with the cities of Carmel-by-the-Sea, Monterey, Seaside, Sand City, and Del Rey Oaks. The mayors of these cities had determined that it was in their municipalities' best interests to form a joint powers authority that would advance the timely development of alternative water supply projects, and, provide a public forum for deliberation and participation in the governance of alternative water supply projects.

The City has made the following payments to the MPRWA:

The MPRWA has issued an invoice to the City in the amount of \$9,226 for Fiscal Year 2015-16 (FY 2015-16). Staff is seeking direction from Council as to whether the City should continue its membership in the joint powers authority.

#### FISCAL IMPACT

Sufficient funds are available in the City Council budget to pay the FY 2015-16 MPRWA invoiced cost of \$9,226.
