

Regional Meeting Participation Report

Monterey Peninsula Regional Water Authority ([MPRWA](#)) – 1st Vice President

4/26/16:

- Heard a report on the joint motion to CPUC for a separate Phase 2 decision on Ground Water Replenishment. CalAm proposes to build the pipeline needed to bring Pure Water Monterey to the Peninsula. The Pollution Control Agency and the Water Management District, plus CalAm, will be parties to a Water Purchase Agreement. In the background is the topic of Surcharge 2 that is intended to fund the pipeline.
- Discussed the “To Do” list for the MPRWA. It’s a big list!
- Considered proposed modifications to the prior CalAm CDO (Cease and Desist Order) extension request to the State Water Resources Control Board. Authorized signing along with other settling parties.
- Authorized the RWA president to send a letter to the Governor’s Military Council on status of the Water Supply Project and the proposed modifications to the CDO.
- Designated Jason Burnett as a continuing Special Liaison for the RWA. This meeting was the last official meeting for former Mayor Burnett. Steve Dallas, incoming mayor in Carmel, strongly urged this action.

Association of Monterey Bay Area Governments ([AMBAG](#)) – 1st Vice President

4/13/16:

- Update on the Regional Growth Forecast for Santa Cruz, San Benito, and Monterey Counties
 - Job growth slightly up from the 2014 forecast
 - Population and Housing unit forecasts slightly down from the 2014 forecast
 - Job growth will be slightly faster than population growth
- Transportation bill for funding road repairs is very distant. Funds are drying up.

Monterey County Mayor’s Association (MCMA) – Member

4/1/16 in Seaside

- Update from Monterey County – Budget gap of \$16 million.

- Heard report on options at the end of FORA's current authorization to 2020. Extensive obligations will continue beyond 2020 and responsibilities and oversight need to be clear.
- Heard an update on the transportation investment plans related to a tax measure.
