SUMMARY

The Emergency Communications Policy Advisory Council (ECPAC) is a policy advisory body to the county board of supervisors. Its remit is the county's 911 call center located in Salinas. http://www.co.monterey.ca.us/911/

Pacific Grove in FY 2013/14 paid the county \$355,000 for 911 services; partially offset by a Proposition 172 grant of \$80,000. Continuance of the grant is uncertain.

Our prior city manager, Tom Frutchey, promoted formation of a Joint Powers Agreement (JPA) in an effort to better align governance with funding. Currently cities pay for 67% of the 911 call center costs. But the county controls 100% of 911 call center operation and cost.

It's not clear at this time how the formation of a JPA is moving forward. However, Salinas retained Citygate Associates to conduct a fiscal feasibility analysis of a JPA. We should contact Ray Corpuz, Salinas City Manager and find out where the study is headed.

The key agenda item (attached) was approval of an extension of the 1-year 'Alternative Governance Model Beta Test'. The test is to evaluate different membership of the policy (ECPAC) and operation (ECUAC) committees. The test would provide insights into the proposed JPA.

The next ECPAC meeting date is not known, but I expect it should occur in 2017.
