RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PACIFIC GROVE FOR
ADOPTION OF THE FINAL SEWER COLLECTION SYSTEM MASTER PLAN

FINDINGS

1. The City of Pacific Grove owns and operates the sewer collection system that consists of approximately 58 miles of pipelines, 900 manholes, and seven pump stations.
2. The City Council received the draft Sewer Collection System Master Plan on May 21, 2014.
3. Through EMC Planning Group, the City conducted the necessary CEQA analysis and approved the CEQA document associated with the Sewer Collection System Master Plan on September 3, 2014.
4. Adoption of the Sewer Collection System Master Plan does not constitute a project under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Guidelines [Section 15378(b)(2)].

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PACIFIC GROVE:

1. The Council determines that each of the Findings set forth above is true and correct, and by this reference incorporates those Findings as an integral part of this Resolution.
2. Having received, reviewed and considered all information in the Sewer Collection System Master Plan, these findings are hereby adopted by the City of Pacific Grove.
3. This Resolution shall become effective immediately following passage and adoption thereof.
