

RESOLUTION NO. 15-061

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PACIFIC GROVE APPROVING A REVISION TO THE FEES ASSOCIATED WITH TREE APPLICATIONS AND PERMITS

FINDINGS

1. Pacific Grove Municipal Code (PGMC) Chapter 6.02 requires fee adjustments to be approved by City Council by resolution and to be held as a public hearing for its consideration so as to recover the percentage of costs.
2. The Current Tree Permit Fee is \$58 for the first tree and \$49 for each additional tree; there is no application fee.
3. To recover a portion of processing tree applications and permits the City will charge a permit fee of \$87 and \$73.50 for each additional tree. An application fee will be administered at \$25.
4. The City Council conducted a public hearing regarding the increase to the tree permits and issuance of an application fee on November 4, 2015.
5. The Fees imposed by this resolution are hereby added and revised in the City Master Fee Schedule to inform the public.
6. This action is not a project under section 15378 (b),(2) of the CEQA Guidelines, set forth in California Administrative Code, Title 14, Section 15000, et seq.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PACIFIC GROVE:

1. The Council determines that each of the findings set forth above is true and correct and, by this reference, incorporates each finding as an integral part of this Resolution.
2. The City of Pacific Grove FY 2015/16 Master Fee Schedule shall be revised to include a tree application fee of \$25 and adjustments to the Permit fee of \$87 and \$73.50 for each additional tree.
3. This Resolution shall become effective immediately following passage and adoption hereof.


