

RESOLUTION NO. 15-007

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH ACCESS MONTEREY PENINSULA TO OPERATE AND ADMINISTER PUBLIC ACCESS, EDUCATION, AND GOVERNMENT (PEG) SERVICES AND PROGRAMING ON BEHALF OF THE CITY.

FINDINGS

WHEREAS, the City desires to provide public access video and cable broadcast of City Council Meetings and other community events

WHEREAS, the City desires to enhance the public's access to local broadcast services and programs through a Public Access Channel

WHEREAS, the City receives Public Access, Education and Government (PEG) funds from cable providers in the City of Pacific Grove to support those activities

WHEREAS, Access Monterey Peninsula (AMP) is a local non-profit organization that provides these services.

WHEREAS, the action proposed by this Resolution does not constitute a “Project” as that term is defined under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), CEQA Guideline Section 15378.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PACIFIC GROVE:

1. The Council determines that each of the Findings set forth above is true and correct, and by this reference incorporates those Findings as an integral part of this Resolution.
2. The Council authorizes the City Manager to enter into an agreement with Access Monterey Peninsula (AMP) to operate and administer Public Access, Education and Government (PEG) services and programming on behalf of the City. The Council further authorizes the City Manager to negotiate and make any necessary changes in the final agreement consistent with the Council’s overall direction and the City’s goals.
3. This Resolution shall become effective immediately following passage and adoption thereof.
