Description: Initial Historic Screening.

Applicant/Owner: Diana Slattery/Manjushri Dharma Center

CEQA status: Not a project under CEQA

Staff reference: Mark Brodeur, Director Community and Economic Development Dept.

Recommended action: Discuss and take appropriate action.

On a motion by Member Hines, seconded by Member Turner, the Committee voted 4-1-0 (Member Travaille dissent) to determine the property to be ineligible for the historic resources inventory because the property does not exhibit the architectural characteristics of the styles described in Section 7.3 of the General Plan or Section IV of the Historic Context Statement. Motion passed.

Chair Mason announced that the Committee is still in need of an architect and that the Committee would welcome an architect who is familiar with Historic Resources in Pacific Grove.

10. Reports of Council Liaison

Councilmember Peake stated that the Ad Hoc HPO recommendations to expand HRC's role will have to be reviewed by the Planning Commission as it involves changes to Chapter 23 of the Pacific Grove Municipal Code. Councilmember Peake suggested to the Committee to actively look for an architect prior to the Planning Commission meeting at which the recommendations will be reviewed.

11. Reports of Staff

a. Local Coastal Program Update

Anastazia Aziz, Senior Planner, informed the Committee that staff has finished revising the Land Use Plan and Implementation Plan documents based on a series of Planning Commission meetings and public comment. Ms. Aziz added that the revised documents were released on October 21, 2016 and that they will be presented again to the Planning Commission on November 3, 2016.
