CITY COUNCIL

A special meeting has been scheduled for Monday, November 30, 2015, at 7:00 p.m. to further discuss the City's options for selecting an interim and long-term City Manager.

WATER

MPWMD. The Monterey Peninsula Water Management District (MPWMD) will hold two public workshops to explain and receive comments on the proposed changes to its Expanded Water Conservation and Standby Rationing Plan. The workshops will be held on Tuesday, December 1, 2015 at 8:30am for Non-Residential Users and at 3pm for Residential Users.

“The proposed amendments reduce the number of Stages from 7 to 4, thereby reducing their complexity,” said Stephanie Locke, MPWMD Water Demand Manager. “They also address a state-wide focus on ensuring that there is sufficient water for people's needs balanced with maintaining the local economy.”

Local Coastal Program Update Workshop # 2. On Friday, November 20, 2015 from 9:00-12:00pm, at the Asilomar Conference Center, Fred Farr Room, the City held a well-attended second community workshop. Over 35 people were in attendance. Coastal Zone discussion topics included an overview of the Local Coastal Program Update process, climate change, sea level rise and potential adaptation strategies. Dr. David Revell provided a technical overview of the issues. Participants sat at tables and with the aid of handouts and maps, generated many ideas and comments for consideration. Each table was facilitated by either a City employee or consultant. Workshop materials are posted on the [Local Coastal Program](#) website.

The [Draft Local Coastal Program Land Use Plan](#) will be revised based on [comments](#) received to date and a Draft Implementation Plan (zoning ordinances) will be crafted. The documents are targeted for release and review in February 2016.

FIRE DEPARTMENT

Hazmat Call on Cannery Row. On November 23, Monterey Fire Department was dispatched to mitigate an unknown white powder released from an envelope at 720 Cannery Row. Multiple units, including Fire Chief and Assistant Fire Chief, responded to the scene. Fire crews established a safe zone and assumed site access control while Monterey County Environmental Health arrived. An exclusion zone was identified with caution tape and three potentially exposed persons were isolated. American Medical Response was on scene and ready to provide services to potential patients after they were cleared by the Hazmat team. The Hazmat Group consisted of an entry team, back up team and analysis team. The entry team took samples and identified the substance as non-hazardous, which was confirmed by Monterey County Environmental Health, and all persons and units were released.




MUSEUM


