



## PACIFIC GROVE WEEKLY SUMMARY

December 23, 2015

### CITY COUNCIL

Major actions taken by the Council at its special meeting on December 19, 2015 include:

- ❖ Interviewed candidates, appointed Ben Harvey as Interim City Manager, and directed City Manager to finalize and execute the agreement.
- ❖ Received a report discussing Brezack & Associates Planning financial summary for the City of Pacific Grove, approved a resolution authorizing the City Manager to execute an amendment to the existing agreement with Brezack & Associates Planning for an additional \$217,615, and directed staff to provide quarterly updates as to cash flow and project.
- ❖ Directed the City Manager to prepare a report as to the economic and related effects of the proposed American Tin Cannery ballot measure.
- ❖ Adjourned the special meeting in honor of the Richard “Dick” Trotter’s who passed early December.

**Holiday Toy Wrap Party and Delivery.** Special thanks to all those in the community that donated toys to the *Monterey Fireman’s Association* (MFA) toy drive and to the numerous volunteers who helped wrap the toys. This effort makes such a difference to families in need and who appreciate receiving the gifts. There were 265 children in Monterey, Sand City and Pacific Grove who received presents delivered by Santa on the fire engine. Several other children from areas outside those cities had arranged pick up of presents at the fire department. A total of approximately 1,600 gifts were distributed. The toy drive is a collaborative effort between the MFA and the Pacific Grove *Kiwanis* club.

**Storm Clean Up.** This week Public Works has been doing some minor clean up after the weekend and early week storms. The storms produced over an inch of rain and Public Works had a few limbs down here and there around town, but nothing significant. We are expecting more rain towards the end of this week and then again next week.

Please take a look around your yards, driveways and examine your trees to ensure that gutters are clear, storm drains within your property are free of debris, and that there are no hanging limbs from any trees on your property.

**Golf Course Clubhouse.** Also this week Public Works has worked with a local contractor to install new counter tops at the golf course clubhouse. The old counter tops had become significantly faded, stained, and had succumbed to water damage. Public Works also removed the large, older mirror that was on the wall and made the necessary repairs. New mirrors have been ordered and will be installed as soon as they arrive. This is a much needed upgrade to the golf clubhouse.


