### **WATER**

### **FIRE DEPARTMENT**

**California “Move Over, Slow Down” Law.** Effective July 1, 2007, California motorists were required to take specific action when approaching an area on a freeway where emergency vehicles and tow trucks are present and displaying emergency or flashing amber lights. Amended on January 1, 2010, the law added Caltrans vehicles, and made the law permanent in California (California Vehicle Code Section 21809).

Known as the “Move Over, Slow Down” law, or just “Move Over” law, when approaching emergency vehicles, tow trucks, or Caltrans vehicles displaying emergency or amber flashing lights, motorists are to move over to a lane not adjacent to the emergency vehicles or vehicle. If not practical or safe to do so, the motorist must slow down to a reasonable or prudent speed that is safe for the existing weather, road, and vehicular or pedestrian traffic conditions. Enacted in all 50 states, this law is intended to protect emergency workers and personnel at the scene of an emergency incident or other situation where public safety personnel and highway workers are present.


