January 22, 2016

CITY COUNCIL

Major actions taken by the Council at its regular meeting on January 20, 2016 include:

- ❖ Appointed Ben Harvey as Interim City Manager and Deputy City Clerk administered the Oath of Office
- ❖ Adopted a resolution authorizing submittal of the CalRecycle Grant Program Application
- ❖ Held second reading and adopted an ordinance to amend the City ban of marijuana dispensaries and cultivation within the City, Chapter 11.100 of the Pacific Grove Municipal Code
- ❖ Approved the proposed Special Events Calendar for the Fiscal Year 2016-17
- ❖ Approved Appointments to Pacific Grove Boards and Commissions
- ❖ Received as information and provided endorsement of the Local Coastal Program Update
- ❖ Introduced and held first reading of an ordinance amending the Fiscal Year 2015-16 Budget and directed publication of the ordinance
- ❖ Approved Use Permit 15-735 and adopted a resolution that included staffing recommended findings and conditions.
- ❖ Approved a resolution authorizing the City Manager to enter into an agreement with Haro & Kasunich and Associates for the study of coastal erosion at Esplanade Park and Sea Palm Park
- ❖ Approved a resolution authorizing the City Manager to enter into a Reimbursement Agreement with Domaine Hospitality Partners, LLC for the costs to conduct a special election
- ❖ Adopted a resolution to call the special municipal election for April 19, 2016 and submit to voters an initiative to add Section 23.31.025 to the Pacific Grove Municipal Code
- ❖ Approved updates to Council Policy 000-17
- ❖ Provided feedback and direction on the City's membership in the Monterey Peninsula Regional Water Authority




Beginning February 1, 2016 cardboard placed out for collection will only be collected if:

Your business subscribes to weekly recycling services and all materials are containerized.

or

Your business participates in the new Cardboard Collection Sticker Program.



GreenWaste understands that businesses have historically placed loose cardboard out for collection and that many businesses face spatial constraints that may prohibit adding containers. If you currently subscribe to recycling collection services and are worried about capacity and/or spatial constraints, you may be able to accommodate your additional cardboard by simply adding collection day(s).

NEW CARDBOARD STICKER COLLECTION PROGRAM

GreenWaste's new "pay-per-use" sticker program allows businesses to place tied/bundled cardboard out for collection. Each sticker entitles its holder to receive collection of up to 1 cubic yard of cardboard (3' x 3' x 3' pile or equivalent). Multiple stickers can be used for material volumes that exceed 1 cubic yard. In order to ensure collection, cardboard must:



Be secured (tied and/or bundled)



Have the sticker prominently displayed

EMERGENCY REPAIR WORK ON HIGHWAY 68 BETWEEN THE CHOMP AND STUART AVENUE IN MONTEREY—STARTS MONDAY

MONTEREY –Crews will be working on a week-long emergency repair project on a two-mile section of Highway 68 (Holman Hwy.) between the Community Hospital of Monterey Peninsula (CHOMP) and Stuart Ave., starting Monday, January 25, Caltrans officials have announced.

Roadwork will consist of one-way traffic control with flagging from 10 am to 2 pm Monday, Jan. 25 through Friday, Jan. 29, weather permitting. **Up to 30-minute delays are expected and motorists are advised to take an alternate route.** Electronic message signs will be posted alerting motorists of the work. The CHP will be present to assist with traffic control.

The emergency roadwork being done consists of repairing the roadway, especially patching the potholes from the recent storm and preparing the road for future inclement weather. Roadwork should be completed by Friday, Jan. 29, weather permitting.

Emergency roadwork will be performed by Caltrans Monterey Maintenance crews.

Caltrans reminds motorists to move over and slow down when driving through highway work zones.




