### Local Coastal Program Update

An informational report regarding outstanding [Local Coastal Program](#) issues was before [Council](#) on May 18, 2016. The Local Coastal Program is noticed for adoption and submission to the Coastal Commission at the June 15, 2016 meeting.

On June 1 and 2, the [Planning Commission](#) will provide direction on outstanding issues, the timeline, and a recommendation to Council.

Land Use Plan policy issues that are under discussion with Coastal Commission staff include:

- Sea level rise and associated hazard policies concerning erosion and flooding;
- Definition of existing development;
- Fencing in the Asilomar Dunes neighborhood; and
- Treatment of the 1998 Coastal Parks Plan.

Implementation Plan issues for Planning Commission direction include:

- Commercial-Visitor Zoning District Height Limits;
- American Tin Cannery Zoning Floor Area Ratio;
- Density Standards for Visitor-Serving Parcels.

### **Pebble Beach Company Inclusionary Housing Project**

**PLN130447 Public Hearing:** The County of Monterey has cancelled the May 25, 2016 hearing date, and instead will hold a public hearing to consider the project on **June 8, 2016** at 9:00 AM in the Monterey County Board of Supervisors Chambers, County Government Center, located at 168 West Alisal Street in Salinas, CA. The project consists of: 1) a Use Permit and Design Approval to allow the construction of 24 affordable housing units; 2) a Use Permit to allow the

removal of approximately 725 trees and associated grading. The [Final Environmental Impact Report](#) identified significant unavoidable impacts to traffic and water supply. ## **FIRE DEPARTMENT**

**Mutual Aid Deployment** – On May 22, 2016 at approximately 4:45 PM, Monterey Fire Department personnel were deployed to assist California Department of Forestry and Fire Protection (CAL Fire) crews at the Metz Fire about three miles southwest of Pinnacles National Park, just southeast of Soledad, California. Strong winds fueled the vegetation fire which quickly spread Sunday afternoon to nearly six square miles. A major power outage in south Monterey County was averted as firefighters were able to keep the flames away from transmission lines. Six air tankers, two helicopters and over 200 firefighters were able to contain the blaze which burned approximately 3,876 acres. No homes or other structures were damaged.



**Jacob's Heart Children's Cancer Center Fundraiser** – On May 28, 2016, Monterey Fire Department personnel will provide fireboat transportation on Monterey Bay for Jacob's Heart Children so that they can experience and be part of the 27<sup>th</sup> *Annual Ke Kai O'Huane Memorial Day Hoe Wa'a* – a hosted outrigger race which helps raise money for the organization. Outrigger Santa Cruz raised over \$17,000 for Jacob's Heart and will be participating in this weekend's race that will take place off Del Monte Beach.

Jacob's Heart Children's Cancer Support Services exists to improve the quality of life for children with cancer and other life-threatening illnesses by supporting their families in the challenges they face. They provide family-centered care that addresses the emotional, practical and financial struggles for families of children and teens during treatment, families experiencing anticipatory grief and those who are bereaved. The local chapter provides support to parents and families of children with cancer in Monterey, Santa Cruz, San Benito and South Santa Clara Counties. 

## **PUBLIC WORKS**

Next week the Department will begin the following two very important projects:

**Lovers Point Watershed Project.** This project will be replacing 6,700 linear feet of storm drain lines, 33 storm drain manholes and 43 catch basins. It will also be replacing the waste water lines within Mermaid Avenue and Ocean View from Lovers Point to Sea Palm. The work will begin Tuesday, May 31st on Park Avenue above Lighthouse, working towards Pine Avenue, replacing the storm drain infrastructure. This project will take 4-5 months to complete. The Public Works Department will continue to give updates through the weekly summary. Please see the attached map showing the work zones.

**City's annual Crack and Slurry Seal Project.** This project will consist of the sealing of various roads around town, primarily in the Del Monte Park neighborhood. The Contractor will be starting on June 1st with the crack sealing and grinding of the current road markings. There will be no road closures for this work, but the following week the slurry seal of the roads will begin. Once the slurry seal starts, roads will be closed for the day until the seal dries. If you are on a roadway that is scheduled to be sealed the contractor will be reaching out to you with a schedule and information pertaining to the project. Please see the attached map of the roads to be treated.

**Road Work.** Through the summer months, Cal Trans will be performing an overlay on Hwy 68 from the intersection of Forest and Sunset to Asilomar. Work started today at the Intersection of Congress and Sunset, moving down the hill towards Asilomar. The work that is being done today and next week is in preparation of new curb ramps at the intersection. A majority of the work will not commence until school is out for the summer, which is May 27<sup>th</sup>. During the construction there will be some traffic detours, lane closures and delays through this stretch of road way.


