Action: Upon motion by Councilmember Cuneo, the Council voted 4-3, Mayor Kampe, and Councilmembers Huitt and Peake dissenting, to approve Resolution No. 16-046 to place a Ballot Measure on the November 8, 2016 election to authorize an Admission Tax and Add Chapter 6.13 to the Pacific Grove Municipal Code. The proposed tax shall be enacted and take effect only if a majority of the voters of the City casts ballots in favor of the measure.

C. Resolution Approving a Ballot Measure to Modify and Increase the Existing Business License Tax

Public comment for this item was combined with Agenda No. 12B – see above. Action: Upon motion by Councilmember Cuneo, the Council voted 2-5, Mayor Kampe, Councilmembers Peake, Miller, Lucius, and Huitt, dissenting, the motion failed to approve the Resolution to place a Ballot Measure on the November 8, 2016 election.

Action: Upon motion by Councilmember Fischer, the Council voted 7-0 to authorize the City Manager to execute a contract with Michael Baker International to provide professional environmental planning services in an amount not-to-exceed \$56,000, conditioned upon the commitment of Holman Building Associates to reimburse the City in full for this cost.

Upon motion by Councilmember Fischer, the Council voted 6-1, Councilmember Huitt dissenting, to continue past 10:00 to complete the remaining agenda items.

Action: Upon motion by Councilmember Lucius, the Council voted 7-0 to authorize the City Manager to enter into an agreement with LF & GW Corporation DBA: Green Line Waste Hauler, Green Line Underground Plumbing Video for professional service for sanitary sewer services in the City of Pacific Grove in an amount not to exceed \$350,000 per fiscal year, for one year with the option to extend the agreement for two additional years by mutual letter.
