NOTICE INVITING SEALED BIDS

STREET REHABILITATION PROJECT

**OCEAN VIEW BOULEVARD
BETWEEN 2ND ST. & CARMEL AVE.
AND
BETWEEN 17TH ST. & SEA PALM AVE.**

The City of Pacific Grove invites sealed bids for street rehabilitation work including storm drainage and sanitary sewer system improvements. The work consists of pavement grinding, pavement patching, asphalt concrete overlay, reconstruction of curb, curb and gutter, sidewalk, curb ramps, repair and replacement of storm drain, catch basins, and manholes, replacement of sanitary sewer main, sewer manholes, sewer manhole rehabilitation, and lateral reconnections, applying thermoplastic traffic striping & markings, raising iron and all other work shown on the plans for the segments of Ocean View Boulevard between 2nd St. & Carmel Ave. and between 17th St. and Sea Palm Ave.

This project will be constructed concurrently with a California-American Water Co. water main replacement project. Each contractor shall be responsible to co-ordinate and schedule their work to avoid interference, hindrance or delays to each other's operations. The Cal-Am work must be completed prior to the placement of the asphalt concrete overlay.

All bids submitted shall meet the following terms and conditions:

1. Bids shall be mailed or dropped off at the Public Works Corporation Yard located at 2100 Sunset Drive, Pacific Grove, CA 93950, no later than 2:00 p.m., on Wednesday, January 19, 2022. Bids shall be submitted in a sealed envelope, and the outside of the envelope shall be clearly marked, "CITY OF PACIFIC GROVE, STREET REHABILITATION PROJECT - OCEAN VIEW BOULEVARD BETWEEN 2ND ST. & CARMEL AVE. AND BETWEEN 17TH ST. & SEA PALM AVE." It is sole responsibility of the bidder to see that his or her bid is received in proper time. Any bids received after the scheduled closing time for receipt of bids may be rejected.

2. Any bidder may withdraw his or her bid, either personally or by written request at any time prior to the scheduled closing time for receipt of bids, but no bidder may withdraw his or her bid for a period of thirty (30) days after the opening thereof.

3. All bids submitted shall include a completed "Proposal", which is included in the Bidder Package. Each bid must be accompanied by Cash, Cashiers' Check, Certified Check or Bidder's Bond in an amount equal to not less than 10% (ten percent) of the total amount of the bid price. The work performed under this contract must conform to requirements of the project Technical Specifications and Special Provisions, which are described in the Bidder Package.

4. The contract will be awarded to the lowest responsible bidder (as defined in the City purchasing regulations) whose work, in the opinion of the Council, will best meet the requirements of the City of Pacific Grove. It is clearly understood by all bidders that said Council reserves the right to reject any and all bids and to waive informalities in said bids.

5. A contractor or subcontractor shall not be qualified to bid on, be listed in a bid proposal, subject to the requirements of Section 4104 of the Public Contract Code, or engage in the performance of any contract for public work, as defined in this chapter, unless currently registered and qualified to perform public work pursuant to Section 1725.5.

6. In accordance with the provisions of California Labor Code Sections 1770, 1773, 1773.1, 1773.2, 1773.6, and 1773.7, the current prevailing wages in Monterey County, California, as determined by the Director of the California Department of Industrial Relations as required to be paid to mechanics and laborers, employed directly upon the site of the work.

7. Time is of the essence for this project and bidders should review the project time frame contained in the "Special Provisions" to insure they can meet the project guidelines concerning scheduling of work and special actions required in the course of work.

8. A Bidder Package, including plans and specifications, special provisions, sample contract, and proposal forms may be seen and obtained at the office of Neill Engineers Corp., SW corner of Mission and Fifth, P. O. Box LL, Carmel, CA 93921, (831) 624-2110. A non-refundable fee of \$75 made payable to the City of Pacific Grove will be required for each set of plans and specifications. Additional charges will be imposed for mailings of plans and specifications. Plans and specifications will not be mailed until payment for materials and postage has been received. A copy of the Bidder Package is also on file at the City Clerk's office in City Hall at 300 Forest Avenue and the Central Coast Builders Association (831) 758-1624.

9. There will be a mandatory pre-bid meeting for all prospective bidders. Attendees will gather at the Lovers Point Park driveway entrance adjacent to the Beach House Restaurant on Wednesday, January 5, 2022 at 11:00 a.m. This mandatory pre-bid meeting will allow bidders to review the project site and ask questions.

Questions that arise after the mandatory pre-bid meeting can be directed to the Project Contact. The last day for questions will be on January 13, 2022 at 5:00 p.m. Any addendums that arise will be uploaded to the City's Bids & RFQs webpage and will be emailed to the contractors that attended the mandatory pre-bid meeting.
