- CDP Special Condition required a Shoreline Management plan by **July 20, 2020**

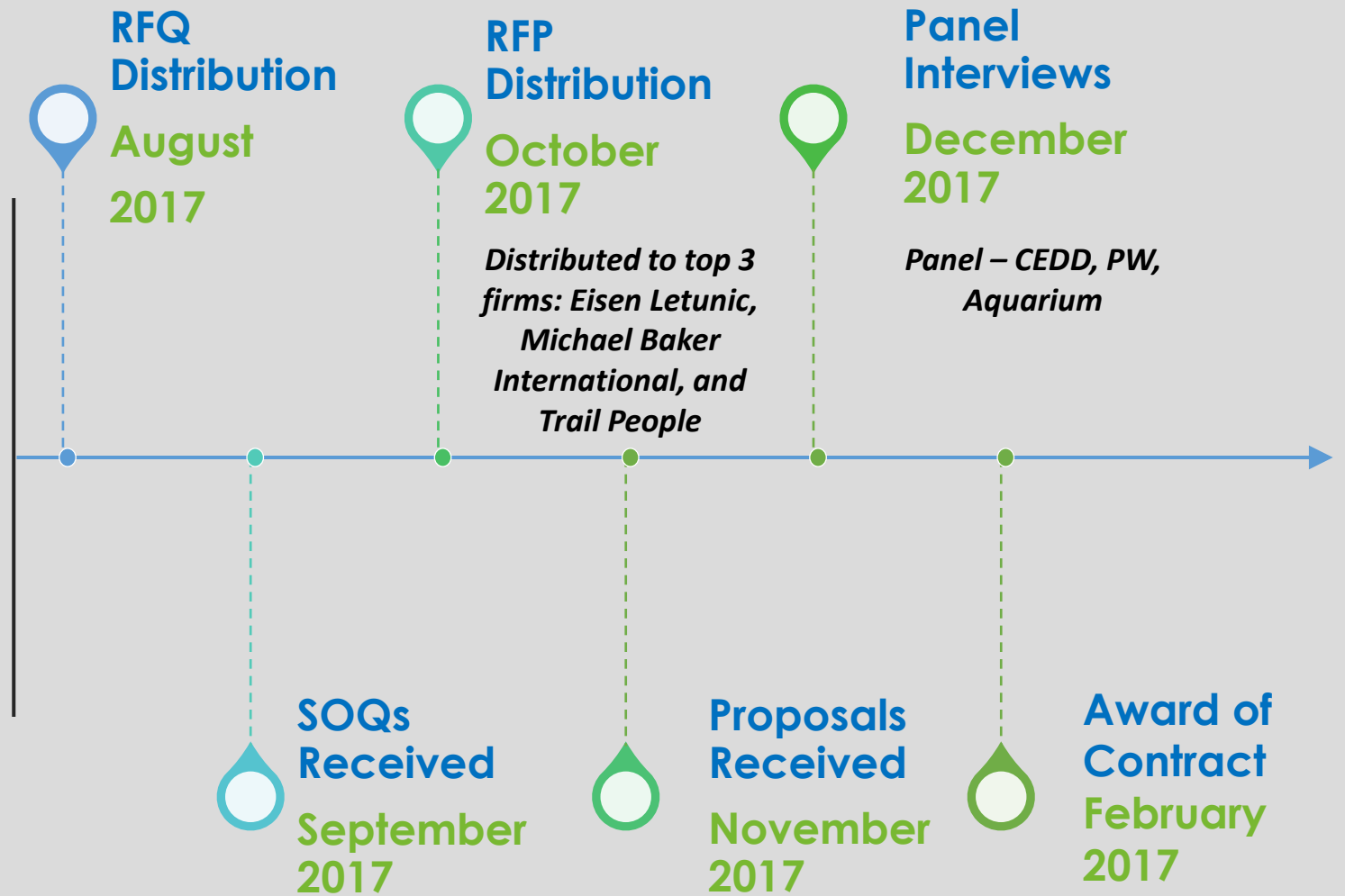
Shoreline Management Plan



Identify ways to provide continuous Recreation Trail access while protecting coastal resources

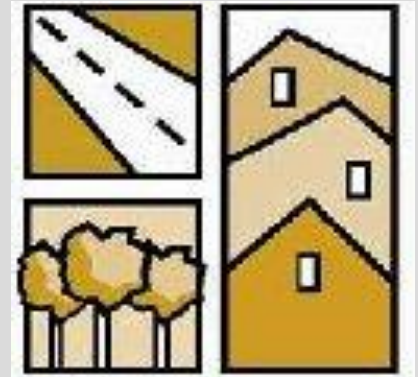
- ✓ Vulnerability assessment
