# Highway 68 Corridor Study

- Conducted in conjunction with TAMC and Caltrans
- Purpose:
  - Identify ways to create a more complete corridor
  - Improve safety
  - Serve the needs of pedestrians, bicyclists, drivers and people of all ages and abilities
- Adopted by Council on October 5, 2016

## Pacific Grove

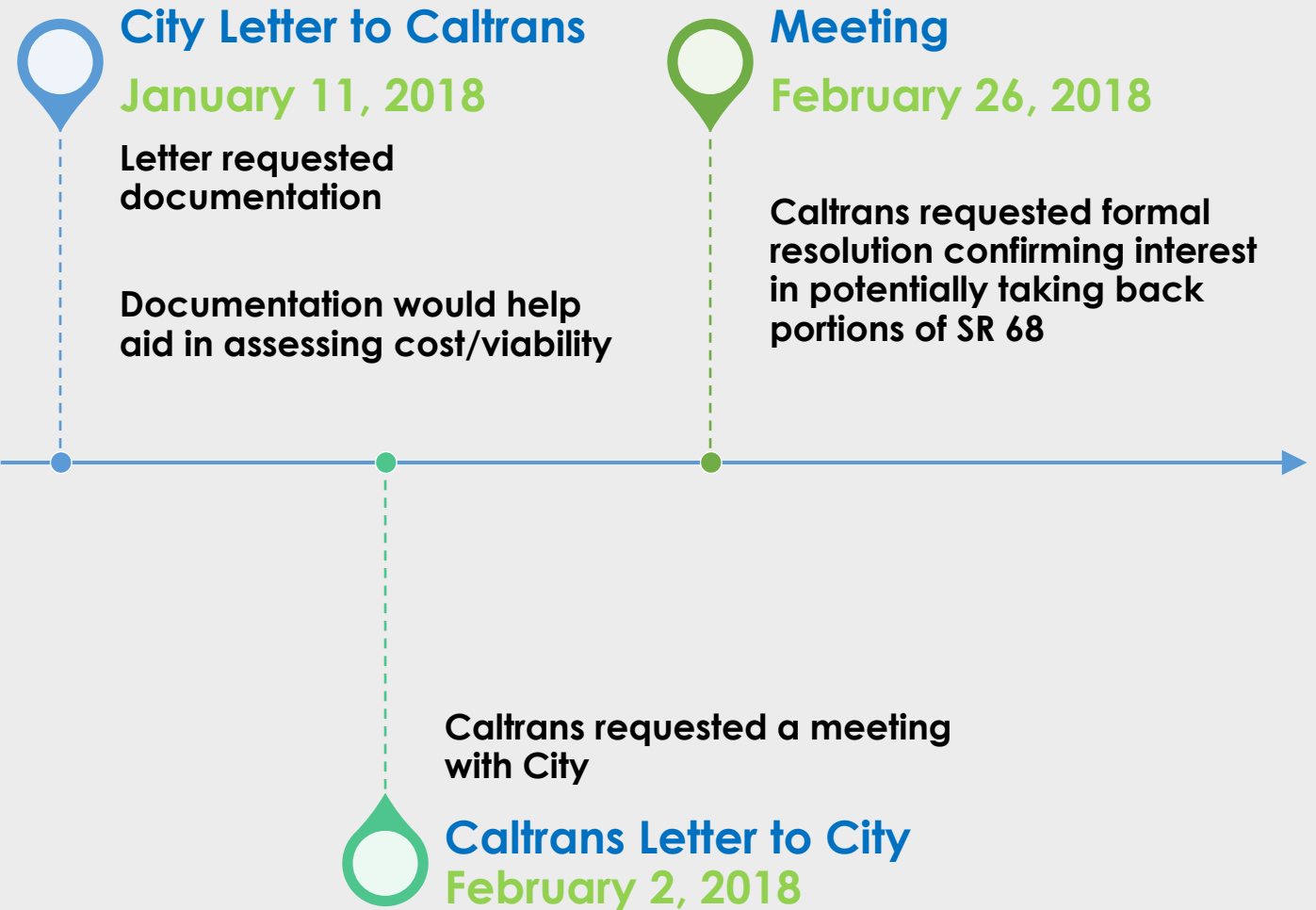


- Owned/operated by Caltrans who has oversight of improvements
- Study includes design standards not in alignment/consistent with those of Caltrans

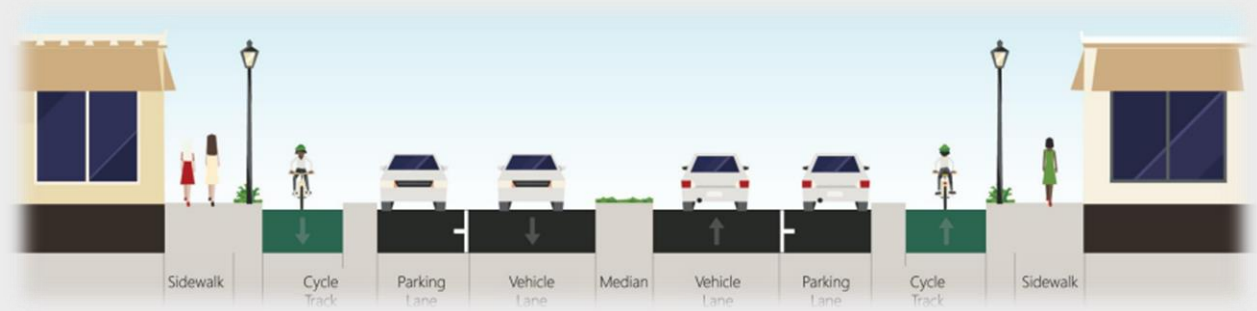
**Only way to implement the designs in plan, without modification, is by taking ownership of a portion of State Route 68.**

**Alternative is to proceed with the elements that meet the Caltrans standards**

# Adoption of a Resolution



**Not a binding agreement**

**Serves the purpose of formally notifying Caltrans of the City's willingness to open negotiations and formally kick off the Caltrans data gathering process**

# If Approved, Next Steps



- Caltrans will initiate the Relinquishment Assessment Report (RAR)
- RAR will provide the City with some requested documentation
  - Additional Documents will be provided as discussions continue
- Documents are vital in assessing viability of ownership of 68 and the course of action for future improvements to the Corridor
