Background

- Many Inquires since 2013
 - Primarily based on Pedestrian and Vehicle improvements
- Preliminary seed funding allocated in FY 17/18
- Formal CIP Project in FY 18/19

Designs

- 1st Designs centered around complete street
 - Ped, Bike and Vehicle improvements
- City hosted community meeting: Aug 2018
- Consensus was to focus on Pedestrian
Improvements: Bikes on alternative roads

Pedestrian Improvement Design

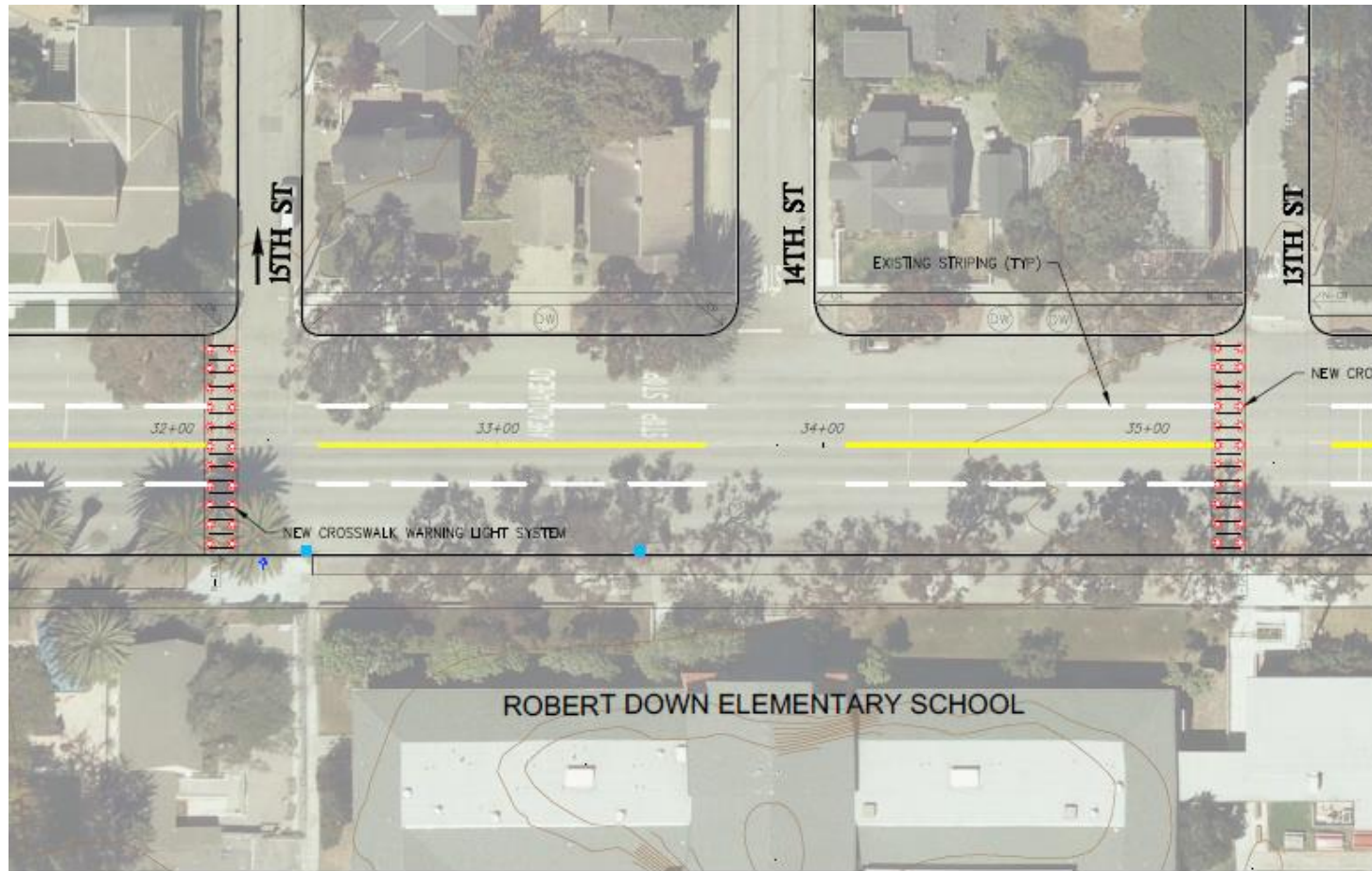
- All Designed presented to Traffic Commission
- Unanimously recommended the Pedestrian Improvements
 - Stop at Congress
 - Flashing Beacon Crosswalks 15th & 13th
 - Improvements at Eardley and Pine

Intersection Designs

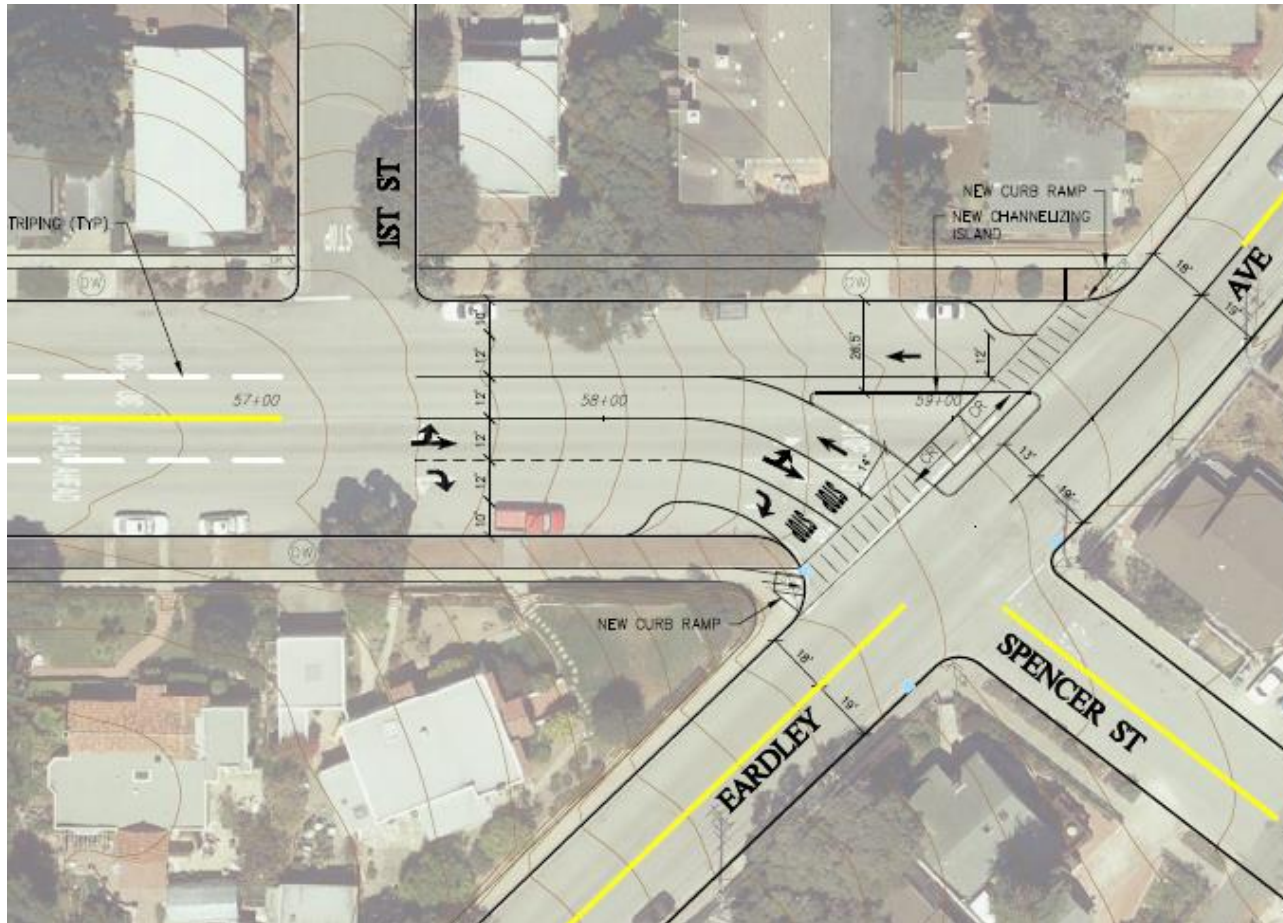
Congress and Pine

Cost Analysis & Recommendation

- Complete Streets Designs
-\$660,000*
- Pedestrian Improvement Design
-\$285,000*

*based on conceptual design estimates
