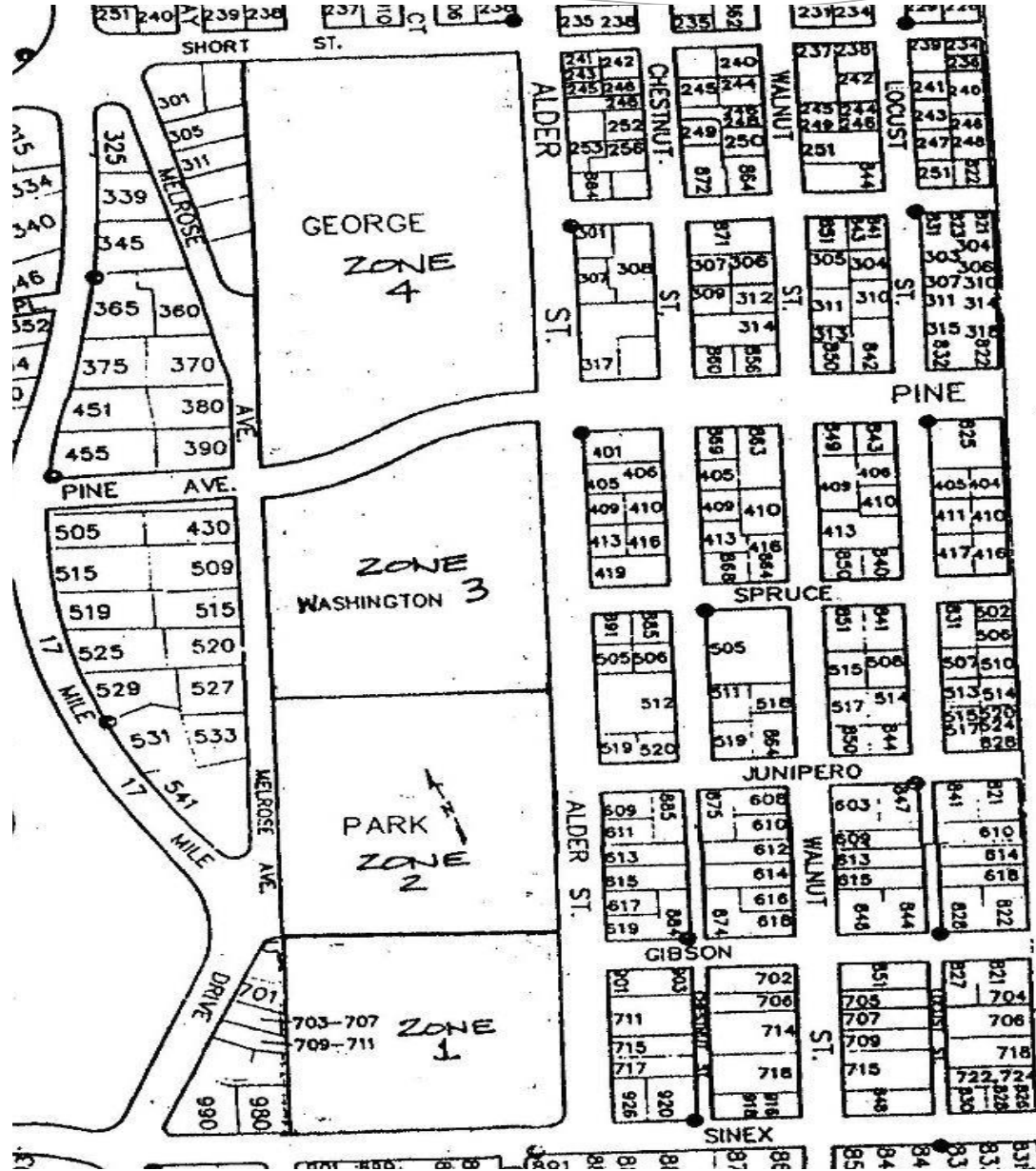

# Purpose

- The City Council in April 2018 asked the city's Beautification and Natural Resources Commission to recommend a course of action for the renovation of George Washington Park.

# BNRC Subcommittee Recommendations

1. Thickets and brush areas are prime wildlife habitat that should be left alone as much as possible.
2. Try goats only in a small test area, prior to any large utilization of goats throughout the Park.
3. If goats are used, replant treated areas with native plants.

# **BNRC Subcommittee Recommendations**

- 4. Concentrate routine trimming, cleaning and improvements on and along established trails.**
- 5. Keep Poison oak along the designated trails.**

# **BNRC Subcommittee Recommendations**

- 6. Plant a large quantity of native pines.**
- 7. Perform annual reviews.**
- 8. Preserve the nature in the park.**

# Recommendation

- Receive the Draft George Washington Park report prepared by the George Washington Park Subcommittee of the Beautification and Natural Resources Commission dated Feb. 19, 2019 and authorize staff to move forward with the recommended maintenance activities.
