AGENDA REPORT CORRECTION

Item 13.b. Page 2 of the Agenda Report First two paragraphs.

The proposed resolution authorizes and directs the City Manager to sell 47.88 AF of water entitlements. This enables water sales of ~~14.2 AF needed~~ to satisfy the current demand 12-31-2018 water wait list, as ~~a matter of priority~~. The proposed resolution reserves 11.5 AF of entitlement water for affordable housing use, to be deducted from the 47.88 of entitlement water available for sale. This amount may accommodate approximately 115 affordable housing units based upon current assumed water demand. (see the City's Housing Element 2015-2023).

If 47.88 AF of available water is used to satisfy the current wait list demand, (~~14.2 AF~~ approximately 21.5 AF as of last report to City Council on March 6, 2019), and to satisfy the affordable housing reserve (11.5 AF), the remaining unassigned entitlement sales will total approximately 14.88 ~~22.18~~ AF. Sales of this remainder will be on a first-come basis. Additional entitlement water may later become available based upon documented performance of the PGLWP.

RESOLUTION CORRECTION

Page 2 of the Resolution.

Corrected paragraph: 2. The City Manager is authorized to sell 47.88 acre/ft (AF) of water entitlements to be distributed and used in accord with Pacific Grove Municipal Chapter 11.68, and further to be sold and used in accord with terms and conditions set by the SWRCB letter dated April 19, 2019. ~~Water sales to satisfy water demand from the 12-31-2018 water wait list shall be granted a priority.~~
