

ORDINANCE NO. 18-010

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PACIFIC GROVE
AMENDING SECTION 16.56.100 OF THE PACIFIC GROVE MUNICIPAL CODE
ENTITLED TRUCK ROUTES**

1. Truck Routes defined in the Pacific Grove Municipal Code (PGMC or Code) are not consistent with the signs posted along the designated routes, and do not connect to the State Highway system and the truck routes on the streets in the City of Monterey;
2. The PGMC should be amended to correct the connections to Highway 68 and to signed truck routes in the City of Monterey;
3. The proposed Code amendments have been reviewed and approved by the City of Pacific Grove's (City) Traffic Safety Commission;
4. In the enactment of this ordinance, the City followed the guidelines adopted by the State of California and published in the California Code of Regulations, Title 14, Section 15000, et seq. Enactment of this ordinance action is a Class I exemption from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), Existing Facilities; and

IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PACIFIC GROVE, CALIFORNIA, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Section 16.56.100 of the Pacific Grove Municipal Code shall be amended as shown in this section. Text shown in *bold italics* shall be added.

16.56.100 Truck routes

In accordance with PGMC 16.44.010 through 16.44.030 and when signs are erected giving notice thereof, the following streets or portions of streets are hereby declared to be truck traffic routes for the movement of vehicles exceeding a maximum gross weight of three tons:

- (a) Central Avenue in its full length;
- (b) Congress Avenue from Lighthouse Avenue to Sinex Avenue;
- (c) Sinex Avenue from Congress Avenue to Seventeen Mile Drive;
- (d) *Seventeen Mile Drive from Sinex Avenue to State Highway 68 (Sunset Drive; and)*
- (e) *David Avenue from the east City Limits to State Highway 68 Forest Avenue*

SECTION 2. In accord with Article 15 of the City Charter, this ordinance shall take effect thirty days following passage and adoption hereof.

SECTION 3. The City manager and City clerk are directed to perform all tasks necessary to implement this ordinance. This measure shall cause republication of the Pacific Grove Municipal Code.

SECTION 4. If any provision, section, paragraph, sentence, clause, or phrase of this ordinance, or any part thereof, or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance, or any part thereof, or its application to other persons or circumstances. The City Council hereby declares that it would have passed and adopted each provision, section, paragraph, subparagraph, sentence, clause, or phrase thereof, irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, paragraphs, subparagraphs, sentences, clauses, or phrases, or the application thereof to any person or circumstance, be declared invalid or unconstitutional.
