

RESOLUTION NO. 15-059

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH ANDERSON PACIFIC ENGINEERING CONSTRUCTION INC. FOR THE TRAFFIC CALMING AND LANDSCAPING IMPROVEMENTS ON CENTRAL AVENUE

1. The City of Pacific Grove ("City") is responsible for structural maintenance of publicly owned infrastructure and upgrades for safety. The Pacific Grove Municipal Code Chapter 2.16.320 requires projects involving an expenditure of more than \$35,000, are approved by City Council by resolution.
2. Neill Engineers Corp., the City's engineer, completed all the engineered drawings and job specification for the 2015 Traffic Calming & Landscaping Improvements on Central Avenue. The City received two sealed bids for the project with the lowest responsible bidder being Anderson Pacific Engineering Construction Inc. in an amount not to exceed \$269,609 plus a 10% contingency fee.
3. Funding has been allocated for this project in the Public Works FY 2015/2016 Budget under the Gas Tax Fund 18, Division 508, and Account 6041.
4. This action is categorically exempt as defined under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) under Class 1, Article 19, Section 15301(c). Existing Highways or streets.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PACIFIC GROVE:

1. The foregoing Findings set forth above, are by this reference incorporated as an integral part of this Resolution.
2. The City Manager is authorized to execute all documents and to perform all other necessary City acts to enter into an agreement with Anderson Pacific Engineering Construction Inc. for the 2015 Traffic Calming & Landscaping Improvements on Central Avenue in an amount not to exceed \$269,609 plus a 10% contingency fee
3. This Resolution shall become effective immediately following passage and adoption hereof.

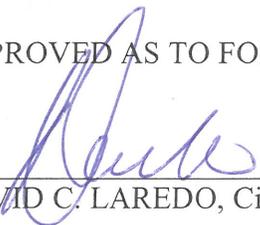
