

RESOLUTION NO. 18-038

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PACIFIC GROVE DECLARING ITS INTENT TO AMEND THE ASSESSMENT FOR THE HOSPITALITY IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT (HID) EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2019, PURSUANT TO THE PARKING AND BUSINESS IMPROVEMENT AREA LAW OF 1989; AND SET A PUBLIC HEARING

WHEREAS, the City Council has established the Hospitality Improvement District ("HID") pursuant to the Parking and Business Improvement Area Law of 1989, Streets and Highways Code §36500 et seq. ("89 Law"); and

WHEREAS, the City Council is in the process of joining a new Tourism Improvement District formed by the City of Monterey pursuant to the Property and Business Improvement District Law of 1994; and

WHEREAS, the '89 Law allows the City Council to modify assessments for the HID; and

WHEREAS, the City Council now intends to amend assessments that fund the HID, effective January 1, 2019;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PACIFIC GROVE THAT:

1. The recitals set forth herein are true and correct.
2. The City Council declares its intention to amend HID assessments for the remainder of the 2018-2019 fiscal year, effective January 1, 2019 pursuant to the '89 Law.
3. The reason for amendment of the HID assessment is because the HID is being replaced by a similar district formed by the City of Monterey pursuant to the Property and Business Improvement District Law of 1994.
4. The time and place for a public hearing on modification of the HID assessment is set for 6:00 p.m., or as soon thereafter, as the matter may be heard on November 7, 2018, at the City of Pacific Grove Council Chambers, at 300 Forest Avenue, Pacific Grove, CA 93950.
5. The City Clerk is directed to provide notice of the public hearing in accordance with Streets and Highways Code §36523 by:
 - a. Publishing this Resolution of Intention in a newspaper of general circulation in the City of Pacific Grove once, at least seven (7) days before the hearing; and
 - b. Mailing a complete copy of this Resolution of Intention to each and every business owner subject to the HID assessment within seven (7) days of the adoption of this Resolution by the City Council.

6. This resolution shall take immediate effect upon adoption by the City Council.


