

RESOLUTION NO. 18-041

RESOLUTION AMENDING COUNCIL POLICY NO. 100-8 MUNICIPAL SOFTBALL PARK MASTER PLAN AND REPEALING COUNCIL POLICY 200-4 MUNICIPAL SOFTBALL PARK RULES AND REGULATIONS

FINDINGS

1. The Pacific Grove Municipal Softball Park, located at the intersection of 17 Mile Drive, Short Street, and Pico Avenue, provides a venue for organized baseball and softball games for youth.
2. Policy 100-8, the Municipal Softball Park Master Plan, provides a framework of operating rules to allow for community use while protecting the residential character of the surrounding neighborhood. The policy also outlines priorities for future improvements to the ballpark.
3. Amendments to Policy 100-8 will allow for more efficient use of the Municipal Softball Park by modifying the scheduling of play, number of tournaments permitted, and hours of play.
4. Changing the title of Policy 100-8 from “Municipal Softball Master Plan” to “Municipal Softball Park Rules, Regulation and Improvements” will mitigate future confusion and more clearly articulate the contents of said policy.
5. Policy 200-4 Municipal Softball Park Rules and Regulations, established by Resolution 6063, provides identical operating rules and regulations contained in Policy 100-8.
6. Revocation of Resolution 6063 will rescind Policy 200-4 eliminating a duplicate policy governing the Municipal Softball Park.
7. This Project qualifies for a Class 1 Exemption under California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) – CEQA Article 19 – Section 15301 (Existing Facilities).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PACIFIC GROVE:

1. The Council determines that each of the Findings set forth above is true and correct, and by this reference incorporates those Findings as an integral part of this Resolution.
2. The Council authorizes amendments to Policy 100-8 as considered at the November 7, 2018 meeting.

3. Council Policy 100-8 is hereby approved and incorporated herein by reference.
4. Council Policy 200-4 is hereby repealed.
5. This Resolution shall become effective immediately following passage and adoption thereof.


