

RESOLUTION NO. 19-030

RESOLUTION AMENDING COUNCIL POLICY NO. 200-3 THE MORRIS DILL COURTS POLICY

FINDINGS

1. The Pacific Grove Morris Dill Courts, located at the Pacific Grove Community Center 515 Junipero Ave, provides a venue to meet the public's recreational racket sport's needs.
2. Policy 200-3, the Morris Dill Courts Policy, provides a framework of operating rules to allow for community use while protecting the residential character of the surrounding neighborhood and outlines priorities for future programming and oversight of the facility. The Policy was adopted in 1988, and amended in 2006 and 2011.
3. Amendments to Policy 200-3 are in response to feedback received from residents who participated in the City's 2018 Recreation Assessment, evaluation of court use during a 90-monitoring and results of an Environmental Noise Assessment conducted from May 27-29, 2019.
4. Amendments to Policy 200-3, allow the courts to be open to the general public during operational hours and assigns the daily management, scheduling and permitting of the facility to the Recreation Department.
5. Re-defining the use of the Morris Dill Courts from "tennis" to "racket sports" will provide clarity to the allowable activities on the courts.
6. This Project qualifies for a Class 1 Exemption under California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) – CEQA Article 19 – Section 15301 (Existing Facilities).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PACIFIC GROVE:

1. The Council determines that each of the Findings set forth above is true and correct, and by this reference incorporates those Findings as an integral part of this Resolution.
2. The Council authorizes amendments to Policy 200-3 as considered at the December 18, 2019 meeting
3. Council Policy 200-3 is hereby approved and incorporated herein by reference.

4. This Resolution shall become effective immediately following passage and adoption thereof.


