HOST LIQUOR LIABILITY INSURANCE	100-3	02/05/87	[1 of 1]

In order to minimize risk and transfer potential liability exposure resulting from the consumption of alcoholic beverages on City property, the following policy is hereby adopted:

~~1. Any person or organization using a City rental facility, including, without limitation, Chautauqua Hall, the Community Center, Rec. Club, and the Senior Citizens' Center, for a function at which alcoholic beverages are consumed must provide the City with a certificate of insurance covering host liquor liability in an amount not less than \$1 million. The certificate must state that the City will be notified at least 30 days in advance of cancellation of such insurance coverage.~~

1. *The City will provide liquor liability insurance to cover events held in the Community Center at which alcoholic beverages are consumed. Individuals and organizations responsible for such events shall pay a prorata share of the cost of such insurance, as may be determined from time to time by the City Council.*

2. If the person or organization imposes a cover charge, sells alcoholic beverages, or otherwise comes under the jurisdiction of the State Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control, the City must be provided with evidence of a valid license from the State Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control.
