

**Revised Notice of Availability of a Draft Environmental Impact Report (DEIR) – Comment
Period Extended to Monday, September 28, 2020**

The City of Pacific Grove has prepared a Draft Environmental Impact Report (DEIR) that is available for public review and comment. This Notice of Availability of the DEIR has been prepared in compliance with the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Guidelines Section 15087.

Project Name: American Tin Cannery Hotel and Commercial Project

Lead Agency: City of Pacific Grove

Project Location: 109/125 Ocean View Boulevard, Pacific Grove, Monterey County, CA. The 5.59-acre project site is bordered by Central Avenue to the south, Dewey Avenue to the west, Ocean View Boulevard to the north, and Eardley Avenue to the east. The property fronts Ocean View Boulevard directly across from Stanford University’s Hopkins Marine Station, near the Monterey Bay Aquarium and Cannery Row. The project is within in the City of Pacific Grove Coastal Zone.

Project Description Summary: The project is a proposal to replace an existing 165,000 square feet of “factory outlet” and related commercial uses with a new hotel and retail use. The hotel and commercial uses would provide 225 guest rooms in two primary guest wings (Family/Group Wing and Executive Wing) with a restaurant and lounge areas, meeting and gathering spaces, spa and fitness center and approximately 20,000 square feet of street retail uses along the Ocean View Boulevard and Eardley Avenue frontages. These street retail uses would retain and incorporate portions of the existing industrial factory structure.

Significant Environmental Effects: The DEIR identified significant or potentially significant effects associated with aesthetics, biological resources, cultural resources, hazardous materials, noise and traffic safety. The project is not located on any of the lists of hazardous materials sites enumerated under Section 65962.5 of the Government Code.

Public Review and Comment Period: The public review period of the DEIR (with Appendices) began on July 30, 2020 and **has been extended to conclude on September 28, 2020**. The City has extended the public review period from an initial 45-day period to a 60-day period as a courtesy to reviewers and to provide for more time for individuals who prefer to review a printed copy of the document or who are unable to access the document electronically.
