

















There never seems to be adequate supervision or enforcement of safety laws at the parks in PG, which is a huge detractor for me and my young family in enjoying our time in PG. To give another example, one time my daughter and I met her friend and friends' grandmother (also PG residents) at Lovers Point to sit on the main beach. Several people were drunk and had open alcohol in plain sight. This was an issue because they were reckless and belligerent. The group was huge and took over the entire back half of the main beach. The played football (grown drunk men) over children and families sitting on the beach. They crashed into us and I was injured. We left and reported it to the police who went down and talked to them, but that was all. It would have been nice for them to have a citation for drunk in public, etc. other times when we visit LP, there are frequently multiple dogs off leash, which we've seen cause safety issues.
