

Annual Perkins Park Clean-Up Event

Saturday, April 13th and Sunday April 14th



Join the Pacific Grove community in the annual Perkins Park Clean-Up event taking place on Saturday, April 13th and Sunday, April 14th from 9am - 3pm. The primary focus will be on pulling weeds, trimming and edging plants and planting new ice plant. Perkins Park is a narrow stretch of shoreline located between Lovers Point and the Esplanade and known for its brilliant pink “magic carpet” or *drosanthemum floribundum* (a.k.a ice plant) that blooms every spring. This annual event is organized by the community members and the city in efforts to restore the park to its’ former glory. Beverages and lunch to be provided.
