 - i. Commander Lakind advised us that the status of the License Plate Vendor review is ongoing
 - ii. Councilman Joe Amelio gave an overview of the last PG City Council Meeting.
 - iii. Commissioner Kim attended the TAMC Bike & Pedestrian Facilities Advisory Committee in January: -Lime started a pilot scooter program at CSUMB in September and hopes to partner with more communities in Monterey County to improve and address transportation issues. They

gave a presentation and demonstrated their smart bikes and scooters. Electric bikes have become more popular among seniors in our area and a smart transportation rental service is being considered by local communities.

-TAMC's Bike Secure program is looking to partner with local businesses and communities. They'll pay for bike and skateboard equipment: corrals, fix-it stations, lockers, and racks. Applications are requested by Feb. 1-7, 2019 and may be considered afterwards, if funding is still available. Businesses and schools can partner with the city/county for encroachments permits on sidewalks. Action: After discussion, Commission Petersen moved that this item be closed as an enforcement issue. Commissioner Kim seconded, and this passed unanimously.
